Who is this initiative for?

- Unemployed asylum-seekers and persons with exceptional leave to remain, who have access to the job market based on the regulations of Vol. III of the German Social Code (SGB III)
- Until 31/12/2018: Asylum-seekers with good prospects of remaining in Germany (As at 11/2015: Eritrea, Iraq, Iran and Syria), who hold a residence permit under the German Asylum Act/certification of declaration as an asylum-seeker (BüMA), and who are not permitted to undertake gainful employment under Section 61 of the Asylum Act
- Entitled asylum-seekers and recognised refugees meeting the requirements for receiving benefits as per Section 7 SGB II, and who consequently receive benefits through the JobCenter Essen.
- You are also able to read Latin script.

You will have access to an interpreter (Arabic) throughout the process. Our staff also speak English.

How does the initiative assist you further?

- You will receive a realistic assessment of your prospects on the German job market.
- You will be given the opportunity to discuss your personal situation through individual consultations.
- Your language skills will be assessed by experts and you will improve your German language skills by participating in the initiative.
- You will receive a detailed certificate of participation at the end.

Duration

2 weeks (10 days from Monday to Friday)
6 hours a day (8am-1pm)

What we offer you

- Assessing your interests, aptitudes and abilities, and determining your professional orientation using a method developed by the L&D Support provider
- Questions can be answered in German and Arabic, English, Turkish, Russian, French and Spanish
- Joint searches for sustainable professional prospects in Germany
- Determining your German language level, and classifying it based on the European reference framework
- Helping initiate the necessary process for having qualifications obtained in your homeland recognised in Germany
- Information about everyday life and culture in Germany
- Information about conditions and requirements of the German training and job market comparing your expectations with reality
- Creating a CV and covering letter for your future applications
- Introduction to the conventional employment websites on the Internet, and using these to look for a job
- Visiting potential work places (companies, establishments etc.)
